There are perhaps two types of activities related to physical space: public and private. This can be also seen as belonging vs. separateness; open vs. closed.

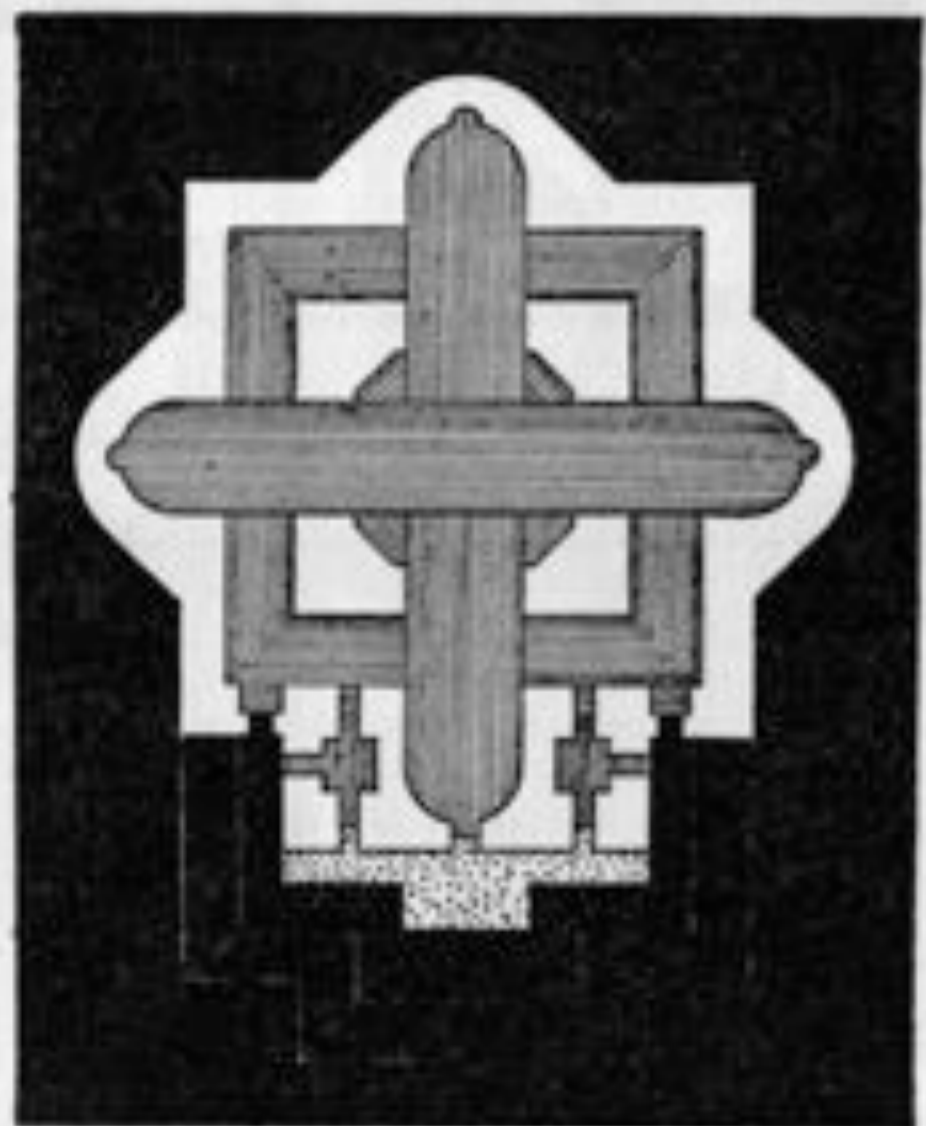
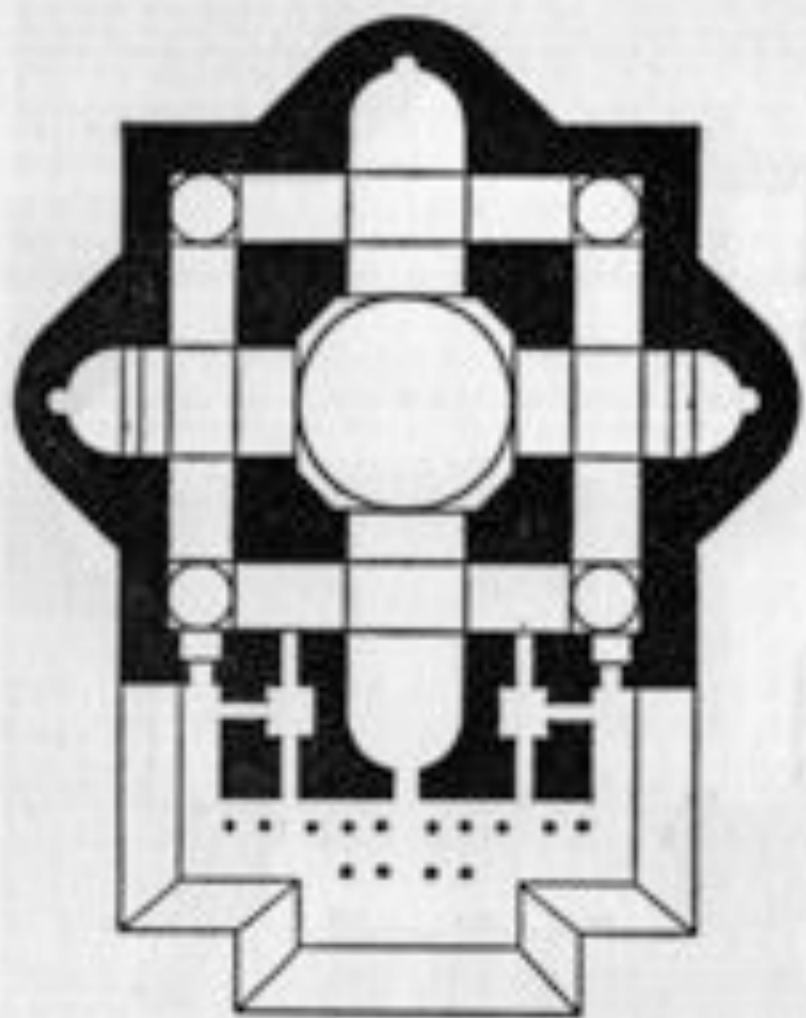
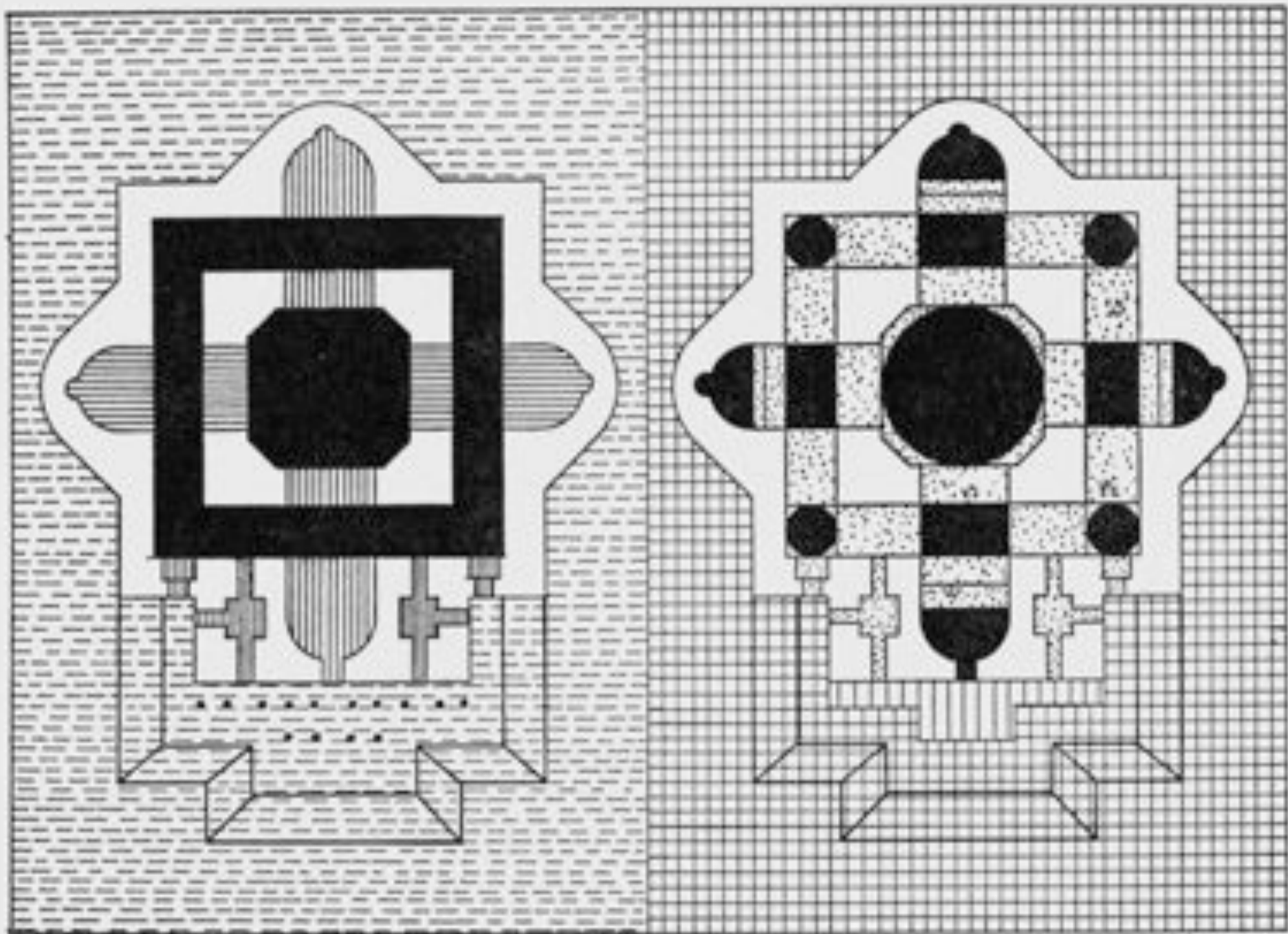

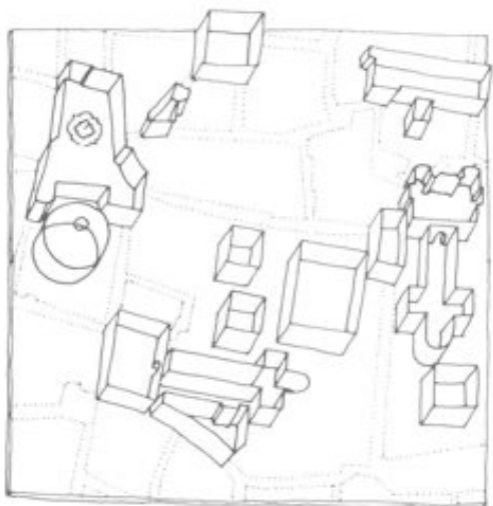
Space can be seen as a tangible field; formed; or solid

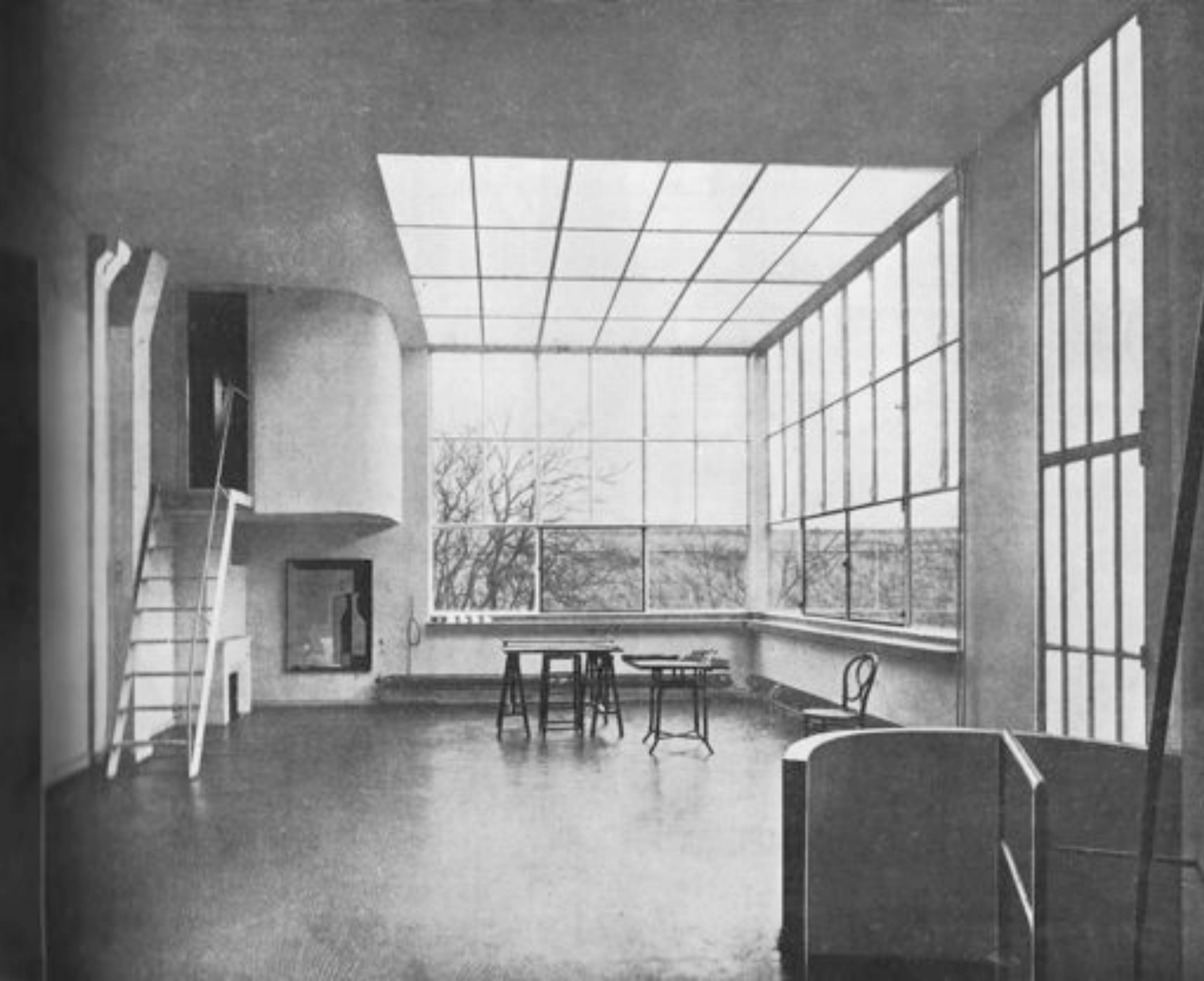

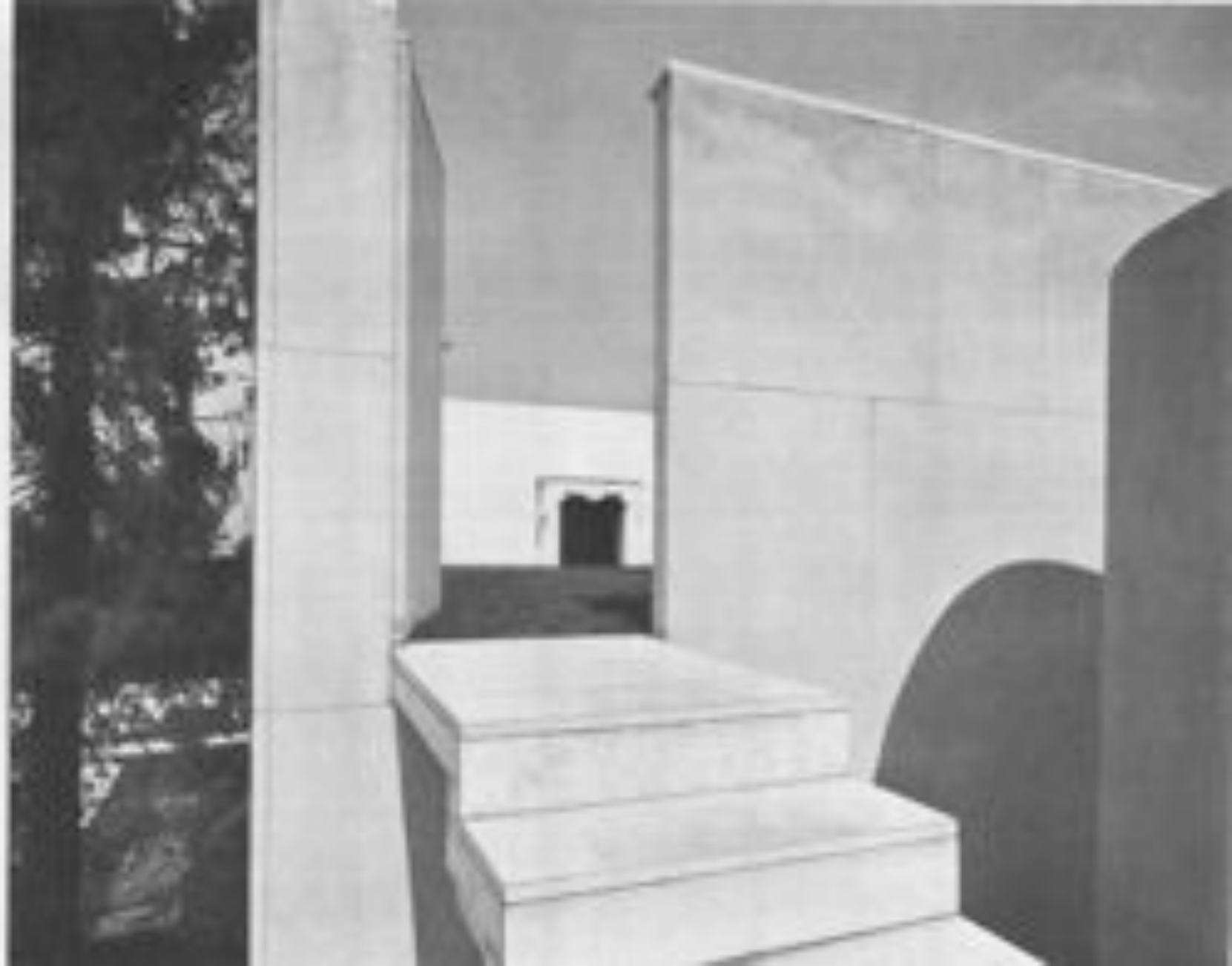

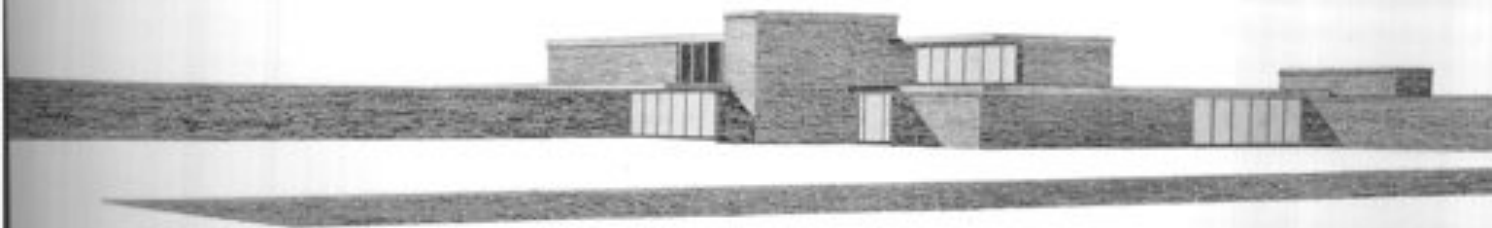
