## The Armchair Environmentalist: Saving Paper

When you are printing a long document and don't need it to be single-sided, you can print duplex on a Windows 2000 machine with most printers. Choose File Print, click properties, then select layout, and then choose one of the 2-sided printing options. Macintosh and Unix machines print duplex by default.

Ever get frustrated while waiting for your output to ē come from the printer? It is possible to check the printer queue and find out when your job will be done. On a Unix machine, or from a telnet session on a Mac, type "print -q -P[printer-name]" to check the g queue. Delete a job by typing "print -P[printer-name] -cancel [jobname]". 5

On a Windows machine goto Start | Utilities | WinKlpq, then select the printer queue you want to view by clicking on the drop-down box. You can delete a job that you own by selecting it and hitting the [Delete] key. The links on the right have more tips.
